



SMOKER BASE DRAWER

Model # 24-SMB

INSTALLER: Leave these instructions with consumer.
CONSUMER: Retain for future reference.



This base drawer is for installation on a Fire Magic Smoker. To install, follow the steps below:

1. Be sure the smoker is completely cool and clean.
2. To reduce the weight of the smoker when resting on its side, remove the cooking grids and the smoker front door. The door is removed by unfastening the three screws found on the top of the door hinge, then lifting up and out.
3. Carefully rest the smoker on its side.

Warning: Use caution when lifting or moving the unit to prevent personal injury, or damage to the unit. Moving the unit will require the help of additional people.

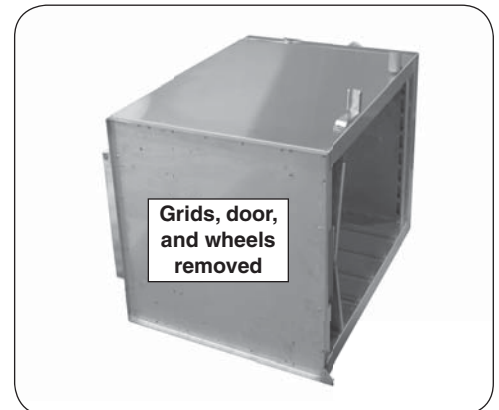


Fig. 1-1 Smoker on its side for base drawer install

4. Remove the four wheels using a Phillips screwdriver. See Fig. 1-1 for unit rested on its side with grids, door, and wheels removed.

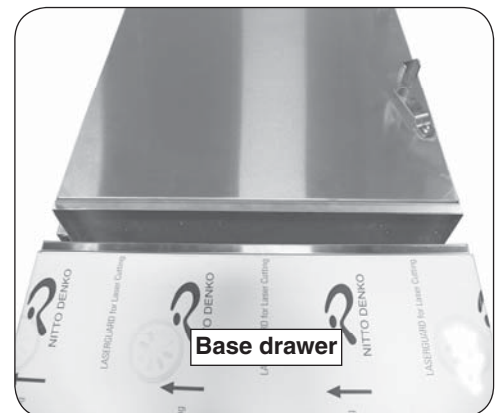


Fig. 1-2 Positioning base drawer to smoker

5. Locate the base drawer assembly and carefully rest one side on the lip of the smoker, then secure the opposite side in (see Fig. 1-2).
6. Secure the base drawer to the smoker using a 3/8 " socket and the 8 provided hex screws (see Fig. 1-3).

7. Install the wheels to the base drawer.
8. Carefully lift the unit up.
9. The protective coating on the base drawer assembly and the base drawer may be removed at this stage. Do not use a sharp object to remove the coating.
10. To attach the drawer into the base drawer assembly; extend the drawer slides completely and align the drawer into the slides, pushing the drawer closed. Open the drawer to verify that it has locked in place.
11. Replace the cooking grids and door.

To remove the drawer:

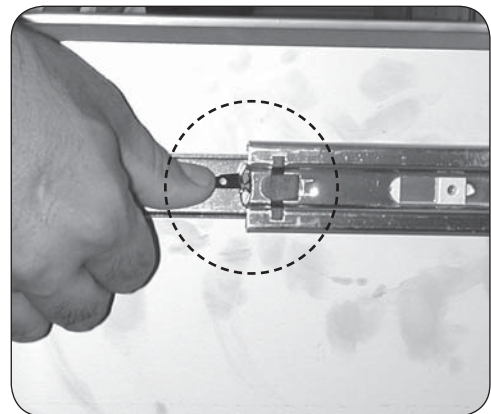


Fig. 2-3 Removing drawer

Pull it completely out. Release the drawer from the drawer slides by pressing the black lever down on the right side, and up on the left side (see Fig. 2-3).
